In her estate plans, Sister June Sattler (1921-2008) of Green Bay, Wisconsin, remembered the Moravian Music Foundation with a generous bequest. The Foundation's Board of Trustees has designated this bequest to provide travel subsidies for residents of the Western and Canadian Districts of the Northern Province,\* to encourage attendance at Moravian Music Festivals. Residents of these areas may receive a subsidy of \$200 per person (with a cap of \$500 per family of three or more Festival participants).

A limited number of subsidies are available, awarded "first-come, first-served"; you'll be notified of your receipt of subsidy right away. You'll receive your reimbursement check when you check in at the Festival.
